Privacy Policy

At Kleer Message, LLC ("Kleer Message") your right to privacy is a concern. The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to inform you of what kinds of information we may gather and how we may use that information in connection with the <u>www.KleerMessage.com</u> website (the "Site").

OUR SERVICES

Kleer Message provides marketing software and services for healthcare providers, including designing and operating websites for those healthcare providers. This Privacy Policy does not apply to the information collected via any healthcare provider's website or other online functionality operated by us, even if the website or functionality includes a "powered by Kleer Message" or similar statement. When we operate a healthcare provider's website, we collect, use, and disclose information only as directed or permitted by the healthcare provider.

COLLECTION OF INFORMATION

There are some areas on our Site in which we may request information from you, including:

- Contact information, such as your name, your address, phone number, email address
- Information about your healthcare practice
- Payment information
- · Photographs that you choose to provide
- Other content you choose to provide to promote yourself or your practice
- Username and password that you may establish on the Site
- · Your feedback and correspondence with us

We may also accept employment applications via the Site, in which case we will also request information about your work experience, education, languages spoken, and other information of the type included on a resume. We take reasonable steps to ensure that information that we receive from you is reliable for its intended use, accurate, complete and current, including providing mechanisms by which you can amend or update your information.

We, our service providers, and our business partners may also collect certain information about the use of our Site by automated means, such as via cookies, web beacons, embedded scripts, and other technologies. We may also use web beacons in our HTML-formatted emails. A "cookie" is a text file that websites send to a visitor's computer or other Internet-connected device to uniquely identify the visitor's browser or to store information or settings in the browser. A "web beacon," also known as an Internet tag, pixel tag or clear GIF, is used to transmit information back to a web server. The information that may be collected automatically includes your computer or mobile device operating system type and version number, browser type, screen resolution, IP address, the website you visited before browsing to our Site, general location information such as city, state or geographic area; and information about your use of and actions on our Site, such as pages you viewed, how long you spent on a page, navigation paths between pages, information about your activity on a page, access times, and length of access. Our service providers and business partners may collect this type of information over time and across third-party websites.

USE OF INFORMATION

We may use personal information to:

- Communicate about the products and services we offer, and respond to requests, inquiries, comments, and suggestions
- Provide our products and services
- Analyze use of our products and services
- Operate, evaluate and improve our business, the Site, and other products and services we offer (including to research and develop new products and services)
- Establish and maintain an individual's profile on the Site
- Administer surveys and other market research
- Analyze and enhance our communications and strategies (including by identifying when emails we send are read)
- Tailor the content we display in our communications and on the Site
- Customize our services to individuals' preferences

- Facilitate our recruitment activities (such as processing employment applications, evaluating a job candidate for an employment activity, and monitoring recruiting statistics)
- Comply with legal requirements, judicial process, and our company policies
- Protect against, identify, investigate, and respond to fraud, illegal activity (such as incidents of hacking or misuse of the Site), and claims and other liabilities, including by enforcing the terms and conditions that govern the services we provide

We may also aggregate and/or de-identify any information that we collect, such that the information no longer identifies any specific individual. We may use, disclose and otherwise process such information for our own legitimate business purposes – including historical and statistical analysis about our customers, sales, traffic patterns and related site information, and business planning – without restriction.

SHARING INFORMATION

We may share personal information with:

- KleerMessage's subsidiaries and affiliates for the purposes identified in this Privacy Policy
- Service providers that perform services on our behalf, or partners with whom we may collaborate, in each case for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy. The types of service providers and partners with whom we may share personal information may include customer service and support providers, technology providers (including technology support, web hosting providers, and email and text communications providers), survey and market research providers, advertising and marketing partners, and analytics organizations
- Business partners whose goods or services may of interest to you
- Professional advisors, such as lawyers, bankers, auditors, and insurers, where
 necessary in the course of the professional services they provide to us
 We may transfer the personal information we maintain in the event we sell or
 transfer all or a portion of our business or assets (or during the negotiations of
 any of such sale or transfer). After such a sale or transfer, individuals may
 contact the recipient with any inquiries concerning their personal information. In
 addition, we may share personal information to comply with legal and regulatory
 requirements, and protect against and prevent fraud, illegal activity

(such as identifying and responding to incidents of hacking or misuse of our Site), and claims and other liabilities.

YOUR CHOICES

- You may choose not to provide any or all of the information that is requested on the Site, but we may not be able to provide our products or services to you in that case. In the event that you no longer want us to process or utilize your User Information, please contact us.
- Some of the business partners that collect information about users' activities on the Site may be members of organizations or programs that provide choices to individuals regarding the use of their browsing behavior for purposes of targeted advertising.
